I get some advice on how should we continue our research, some of them required instruments that we don't have at our department. So if our group decided to choose one of these we will cooperate with one of the other institutes. For my personal opinion monitoring, mitochondrial changes with a High-Resolution FluoRespirometry would give us new results which could be really useful in understanding the pathophysiology of remote ischemic preconditioning.*
